## Introduction

1. The disciples were discouraged and disappointed even after Jesus' resurrection
2. They returned to fishing
3. Then the risen Lord appeared before them
4. Commissioned them saying, "follow me..."
5. He is the Lord of Easter
6. This Easter His commission for the church is that we follow Him
7. How do we follow the Lord of Easter?

### First Reading (Acts 5:28-32. 40-41)

We are witnesses to these things, and so is the Holy Spirit.

### Second Reading (Revelation 5:11-14)

The Lamb that was sacrificed is given glory by heavenly hosts, by humanity and by the whole of creation.

### Gospel (John 21:1-19)

Jesus appears to the disciples while they are fishing, and the catch is bountiful after he instructs them. They are recommissioned to be his witnesses in the world.

### Reflection

Being aware of one's calling to be a disciple of the Lord Jesus can be both joyful and challenging. Being followers of Jesus gives our lives meaning and direction. The joyful experience comes from knowing that the Risen Lord Jesus is with us, empowering us through the Holy Spirit, to give witness to the Good News. The challenging aspect of being a disciple comes when we meet opposition for our belief in the Risen Lord. We must be faithful to proclaiming the Gospel in the Name of the Lord Jesus. That will give us the strength when difficult times come and allow us to rejoice in the Name of the Lord – Jesus.

**May the Lord Jesus continue to touch your life so that you will be able to reach out in a loving and caring way to those whom God has entrusted to your care, and may you sense the joy of being a disciple of the Lord Jesus, especially at that times when you are challenged.**
