possible for us to be with Him, His **Abba**-Father, and the Holy Spirit –
and with all those who have been faithful and are in heaven –
for all eternity.

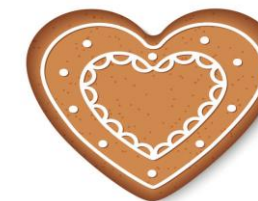
