32nd SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (B)

**“The Lord upholds the widow and orphan,
 but thwarts the path of the wicked.”**

First Reading (1 Kings 17:10-16)

The prophet Elijah is given water and sustenance by a poor widow and the generous sharing of her meager resources is rewarded with a miraculous multiplying of food.

Second Reading (Hebrews 9:24-28)

As Christ died to forgive every one of us, we are safe in Christ's loving forgiveness.

Gospel (Mark 12:38-44)

Jesus admires the generosity of a poor widow, but criticises the Temple for taking what she cannot really afford.

Reflection:

The widow in the Gospel was able to let go of her security by giving her last coins – a small deed of love. We are called to be selfless with the resources at our disposal, particularly supporting poor and vulnerable people.

Today's readings encourage us to rely on God for all our needs, and thank God each day for the many blessings received and the small deeds of love that we experience.

Remembrance Day Sunday, November 11



On Remembrance Day all members of the armed forces who died and gave their lives so that we may enjoy our freedom are commemorated. The other common name for this day is Armistice Day which marks the date and time when armies stopped fighting World War I, November 11th at 11a.m. in 1918 (the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month). Many Canadian soldiers died in the First and Second World Wars, the Korean War and on other battle grounds.

This is the day we pray for peace, to consider what we are doing as individuals, as a community and as a nation to bring God's peace into the world.

WARDENS' ELECTION - December 2, 2018

According to the Fabrique Act a meeting for the purpose of an election of 2 Wardens must take place every year. A meeting will take place for the election of 2 Wardens, on December 2nd, 2018 after the 10:30 a.m. in the Parish hall.

This is a 3 year Mandate and a Warden can run for 2 consecutive terms of 3 years after which they must step down for a year.

The person must be a parishioner and living within the Parish boundaries of Cote St Luc.

These 2 vacant positions must be filled.
